



Welcome New Mexico Retiree Health Care Authority Members!

Thank you for your interest! Members eligible to select Delta Dental plans include:

- ✓ Newly eligible members and their dependents, who may enroll on dates individually applicable to them (based on NMRHCA eligibility guidelines).
- ✓ Individuals currently enrolled in another NMRHCA dental plan who would like to switch to Delta Dental. These individuals may switch to Delta Dental only during a NMRHCA switch or open enrollment.

Please note that prior disenrollment in a NMRHCA dental plan may make some individual members ineligible. Eligibility is determined by, and submitted to Delta Dental from the NMRHCA. There are two Delta Dental plan options:

1. The **Basic Plan** covers Preventive Services (such as exams and cleanings), and Basic Services, (such as fillings or extractions). This plan does not cover any type of Major Service.

Premiums for the Basic Plan are:

\$14.56 per month Individual Retiree
\$27.31 per month Retiree plus 1 dependent
\$45.75 per month Retiree plus 2 or more dependents

2. The **Comprehensive Plan** includes all the coverage applicable under the Basic Plan *plus* coverage for Major Services (such as crowns, dentures and implants), and Orthodontic Services. The Comprehensive Plan also offers a higher annual plan maximum when services are received from an “in-network” Delta Dental dentist.

Premiums for the Comprehensive Plan are:

\$30.84 per month Individual Retiree
\$58.60 per month Retiree plus 1 dependent
\$94.59 per month Retiree plus 2 or more dependents

For both the Basic and Comprehensive dental plans, premiums are guaranteed through June of 2010.

In all NMRHCA dental plans, benefits are greatly reduced if services are received from a dentist who is not “in-network”. When selecting *any* dental plan, make sure to use a participating dentist! Please note that

Participating dentists outside New Mexico: When dental services are received outside New Mexico, Delta Dental PPO dentists serve NMRHCA members as the “in-network” selection. Delta Dental PPO is the country’s largest preferred provider network, with over 106,000 locations nationwide.
